In an age of speed and constant activity, rest appears idle and counter intuitive. 24-hour economies, high speed internet connecting various interests in religion, commerce and industry, volatile global politics and financial markets, the return of the space race, delicate social ties slowed down by one of the most ravaging pestilences of our time are some of the markers of our time. Despite the rush to conquer space, we are reminded that there is real treasure in time. Camp meeting is a special season of refreshing. It allows us to enter that realm and to find that rest is active and purposeful. Not a cessation of activity but the opportunity to grow; to learn and unlearn; to be owned.

In their pilgrimage through the wilderness, God gave the Jewish nation seven instructive feasts pointing to various celebrations during the year. Starting from the feast of the Passover, 14th day of the first month (marking the night of deliverance from Egyptian bondage Lev 23:5), to the feast of tents/tabernacles or booths, signifying God sheltering of the children of Israel in the wilderness and God's provision for them during the whole year (Lev 23:33-36).

These feasts pointed to specific aspects of Christ's ministry in the salvation of man and fulfilled in His life, death, resurrection, and ascension to glory.

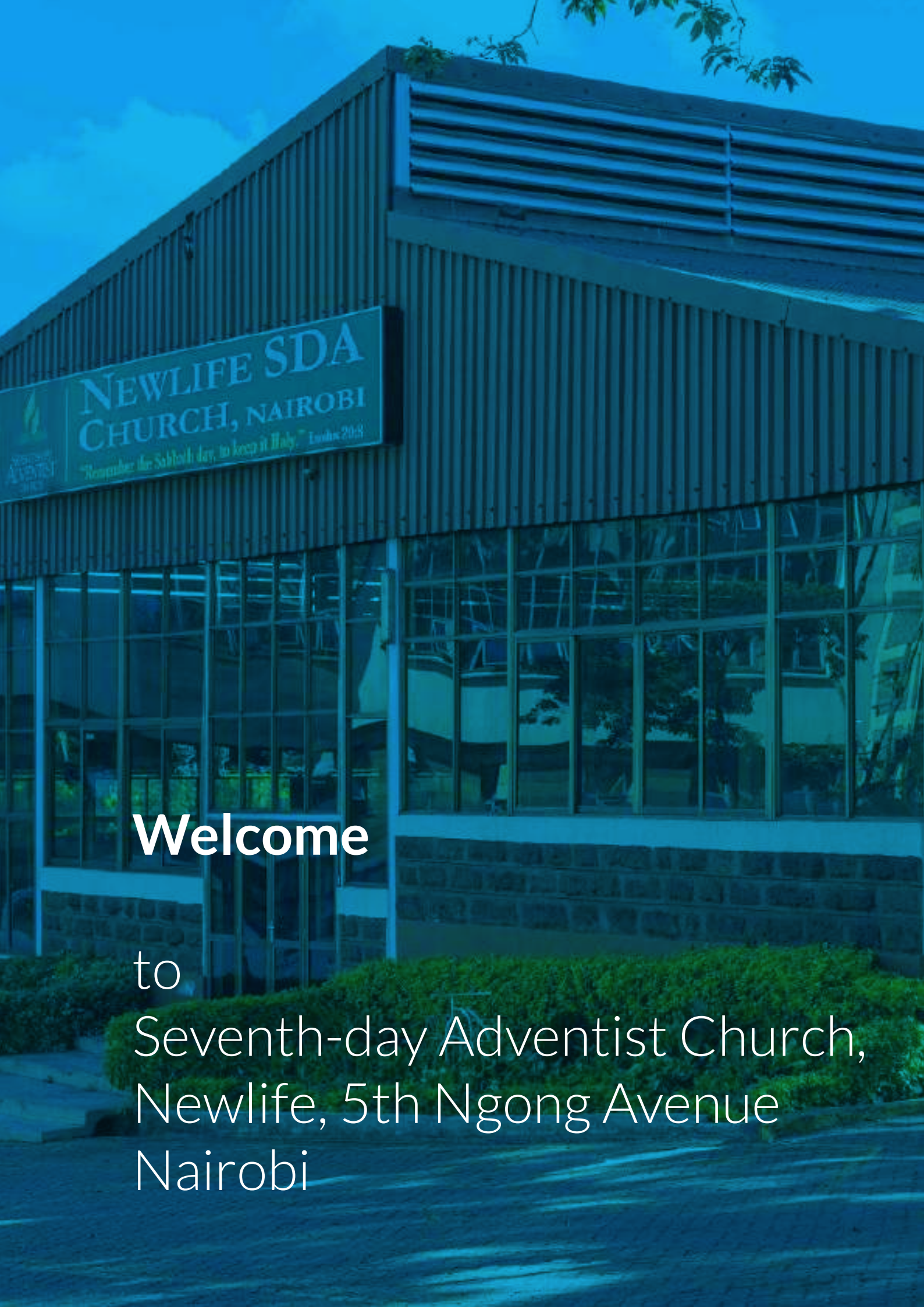
Several Protestant churches adopted and maintained the Feast of Tabernacles, popular as Campmeeting today as an important agency of arresting the attention of God's children and promoting spiritual life among church members. The campmeetings were a critical feature of the Second Great Awakening that rekindled the spirit of the Protestant reformation and led to great spiritual revival and social reform.

So, we may expect a revival of primitive godliness, a renewal of evangelistic fervour as we focus on the fight of the first angel of Revelation 14:6-7 in missions of mercy bearing the evangel, God inspired counsels and effectual, fervent prayers, singing and instrumental music in praise to God, community engagement, the liberating present truth (*Testimonies for the Church*, vol. 6, p. 32-64)

As you enjoy the rest that only Jesus gives, we unite our voice with that of Apostle Paul: "I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship Romans" 12:4.

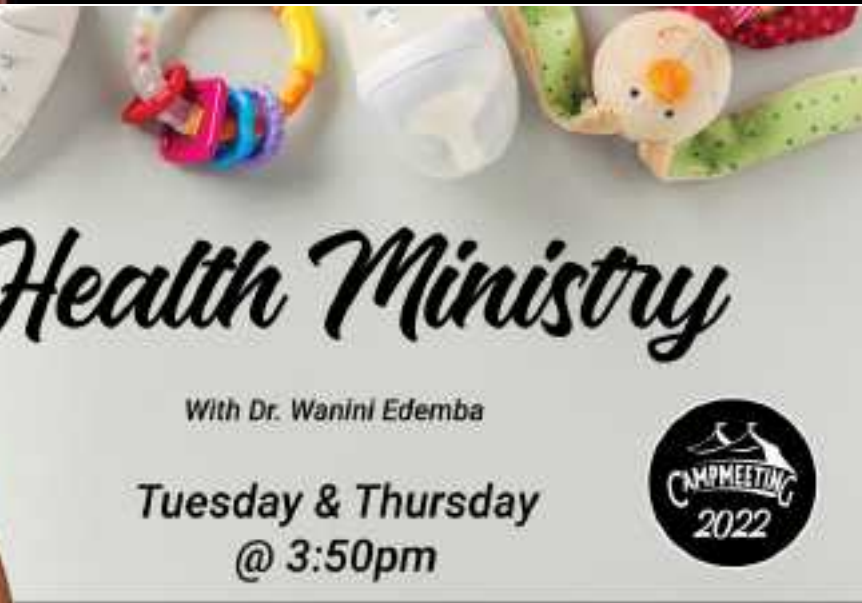
