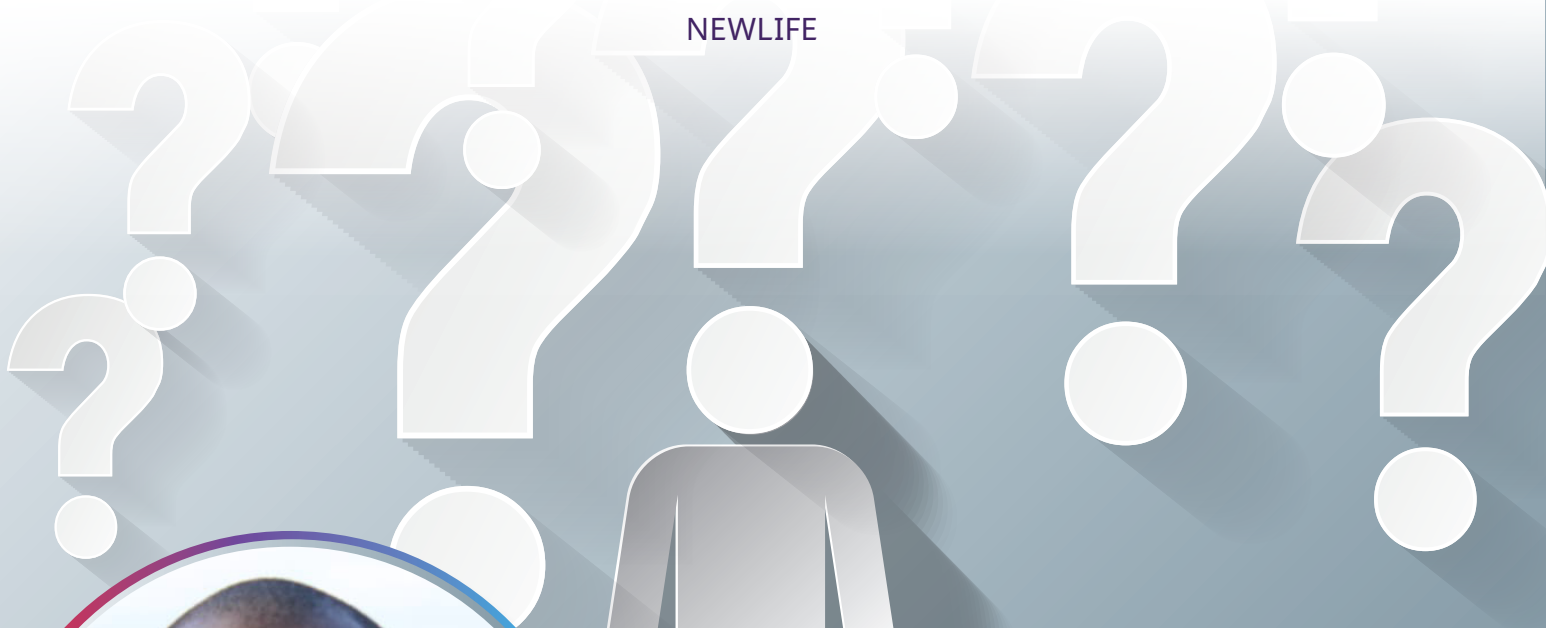

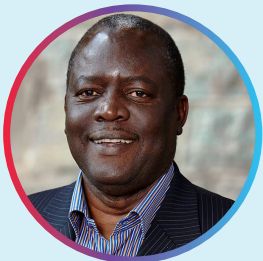
Emily Mochama

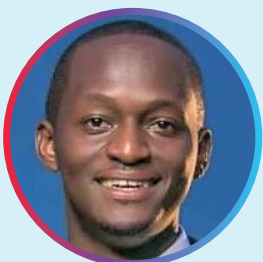
Sis. Mary Angáwa
