

PASTORAL MESSAGE

Jesus Christ is the "Light that comes into the world and shines on all mankind" John 1:9. We do not need to strive to bring God to a people. He has already prepared the way for a greater understanding of His truth among the people. Our approach to evangelism is to proclaim the doctrines in proper perspective, but it is also important to note that love should be of preeminence. We should avoid referring to people of other faiths as "heathen targets" and aim to totally eliminate terms like "crusade" which carry significantly negative connotations among Muslims, for example.

Our relationship with Muslims should lead us to search for evidence of God's activity in the history and current life of the people. This can be found in legends, dreams, supernatural events, people honoured as spokespersons for the divine, linkages to biblical stories, people or events. The gospel is redemptive and that should form the focus of our relationship with the Muslim world, since we can trace our roots into a common Abrahamic ancestry. Sabbath shalom.
