PASTORAL MESSAGE

PASTORAL MESSAGE: SPIRITUAL THIRSTY

The Bible says: "With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation." On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to me and drink. HE WHO BELIEVES IN ME, AS THE SCRIPTURE HAS SAID, OUT OF HIS HEART WILL FLOW RIVERS OF LIVING WATER."

Feeling thirsty is another experience altogether. When thirst is quenched, the feeling is awesome and relieves the soul. How does it feel when you are extremely thirsty due to the scorching sun and served with cold flesh water? imagine/recall that feeling! Jesus the living water. This is a common biblical phrase, serving to invite God's people from all walks of life to come and be spiritually refreshed.

"Every true disciple is born into the Kingdom of God as a missionary. He who drinks the Living Water becomes a fountain of life. The receiver becomes a giver. The grace of Christ in the soul is like a spring in the desert, welling up to refresh all, and making those who are ready to perish eager to drink of the water of life."

"God expects personal service from everyone to whom He has entrusted a knowledge of the truth for this time. Not all can go as missionaries to foreign lands, but all can be home missionaries in their families and neighbourhoods.... To save souls should be the life work of everyone who professes Christ. We are debtors to the world for the grace given us of God, for the light which has shone upon us, and for the discovered beauty and power of the truth."






