PASTORAL MESSAGE

PASTORAL MESSAGE:A CALL FOR SERIOUS AND RESPONSIBLE PARENTING

Being a children's ministry Sabbath let me draw your attention to these profound and richly packed Biblical texts.

2 Timothy 3:15: "–and that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus". Proverbs 22:6: "Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it".

Parenting is a noble duty that the lord has given every parent, but the way it's usually done shows a lot of discord and lack of seriousness. The pen of inspiration has this to emphasize. 'There is a time for training children and a time for educating youth, and it is essential that in school both of these be combined in a great degree. Children may be trained for the service of sin or for the service of righteousness. The early education of youth shapes their characters both in their secular and in their religious life. Solomon says, "Train up a child in the way he should go; and when he is old, he will not depart from it." This language is positive. The training which Solomon enjoins is to direct, educate, and develop. In order for parents and teachers to do this work, they must themselves understand "the way" the child should go. This embraces more than merely having a knowledge of books. It takes in everything that is good, virtuous, righteous, and holy. It comprehends the practice of temperance, godliness, brotherly kindness, and love to God and to one another. In order to attain this object, the physical, mental, moral, and religious education of children must have attention.' {Reference: Child Guidance by Sister Ellen G. White page 297, paragraphs 1 and 2}


17. Music Concert
