Happy New Year! Happy Sabbath! Shabbat Shalom!

Today, being the first Sabbath of this month and this New Year 2025, we celebrate Pastoral/Prayer and Fasting Sabbath. Pr. Jacob Achewa Akali will be break the bread of life. He has a message titled: "LORD I Believe". As we reflect on God's Love, let us pray for Pr. Akali and all those serving today, asking for God's guidance, blessings, and inspiration as they lead us in worship.

PASTORAL MESSAGE: "LET GO!"

"Do not remember the former things, Nor consider the things of old." (Isaiah 43:18, NKJV)

Do not remember the former things. As Isaiah wrote prophetically to Israel, they were mired in the desperate circumstances of captivity and exile. God wanted to put their eyes on the new work He would do, so He began with a reminder to not remember the former things. If they were stuck in the failure, sin, and discouragement of the past, they would never go forward to the new thing God had for them.

It is a fascinating – and instructive – switch between Isaiah 43:16-17 and Isaiah 43:18. In Isaiah 43:16-17, Israel was told to look to the past by remembering the great things God did for them at the Red Sea. However, in Isaiah 43:18, they were told, "do not remember the former things, nor consider the things of old". This shows us that there is a sense in which we must remember the past, in terms of God's great work on our behalf. There is also a sense in which we must forsake and forget the past, with all its discouragement and defeat, and move on to what God has for us in the future.

It is my prayer that we put a side all discouragements, defeats, setback, challenges etc. which we might have faced last year and move forward with hope, faith and love in Christ Jesus.



c. Church Membership Review Campaign


The church is in the process of reviewing and updating its Register of Members. Church Members are requested to visit our website
