Happy Sabbath! Shabbat Shalom!

A warm welcome to the grand climax of the 10 Days of Prayer! Over the past ten days, we have been richly blessed by the ministry of Pr. Douglas Ochanda, who has faithfully presented God's Word in its purity. Today, during the Divine Service, he will once again break the Bread of Life with a sermon titled "Grounded Firm and Deep." As we gather, let us reflect on God's love and lift in prayer Pr. Douglas and all those ministering, asking for God's guidance, blessings, and inspiration as they lead us in worship.

Following the Divine Service, we will take an afternoon rest and later reconvene for a **PRAYER NIGHT**, starting at 9:00 PM and continuing until tomorrow, Sunday, at 5:00 AM. For those unable to join physically, you are welcome to participate online via our YouTube or Facebook channels.

May this concluding day of prayer be a time of renewal and spiritual growth. We trust that God will pour out His blessings as we come together in ACTS (Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, and Supplication) of worship and intercession.

PASTORAL MESSAGE: "NOTHING BUT PRAYER AND FASTING"

So He said to them, "This kind can come out by nothing but prayer and fasting." (Mark 9:29 NKJV)

Prayer and faith are completely entwined. It is faith that drives us to talk to God, to tell Him our needs, and to express to Him how we rely on Him.

Many wonder why we should pray at all if God knows everything we need. That's a selfish view of prayer, as if it is only to compel God to give us what we want. It is often noted that prayer doesn't change God, it changes us. Especially in cases like this, where Jesus' followers are expected to act with the power of God, we need prayer to maintain and strengthen our relationship with God.

This emphasis on prayer shows that faith only works in the context of a relationship with God. We can't make a single decision to follow Him and then forever enjoy the benefits of His empowerment. We don't have the capacity to hold that much strength, like some kind of spiritual capacitor. We must be renewed every day.

Jesus here affirms there are different types of demons with different characteristics, but He does not give details. Passages such as Daniel 10 and Mark 5:10 hint that some demons may be assigned or restricted to a specific geographical location.

The nine disciples were yet pondering upon the bitter fact of their own failure; and when Jesus was once more alone with them, they questioned, "Why could not we cast him out?" Jesus answered them, "Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you. Howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting." Their unbelief, that shut them out from deeper sympathy with Christ, and the carelessness with which they regarded the sacred work committed to them, had caused their failure in the conflict with the powers of darkness. {The Desire of Ages, Chapter 47, Page 429, Paragraph 4}

We invite you to pray "in your closet." We invite you to pray with your local church family. And we invite you to the global Revival and Reformation initiative of prayer. Perhaps you will choose to fast as well? You may not choose to fast totally from food. Perhaps you will fast from desserts or social media, or eat sparingly of plant-based food for a time.

"Now and onward till the close of time the people of God should be more earnest, more wide-awake, not trusting in their own wisdom, but in the wisdom of their Leader. They should set aside days for fasting and prayer" (Ellen G. White, Review and Herald, Feb. 11, 1904).

Pray until something happens and beyond.


c. Church Membership Review Campaign

Dear Beloved Church Members,

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ!

Thank you for your steadfast support, which has been instrumental in bringing our classroom project this far.

We are pleased to share that we have accomplished the basics of constructing the two classrooms. To address immediate needs, we installed a temporary PVC carpet for flooring to manage dust and plastered one wall in each classroom to create functional blackboards. The remaining plastering and permanent flooring are scheduled for completion during the upcoming half-term break.

Our most pressing need now is windows and doors. To complete this phase, we require KES 128,000 to cover the cost of doors, windows, materials, windowpanes, and associated labor.
