# PASTORAL MESSAGE: "AGENT OF DIVINE COMMUNICATION"

Then I saw another angel flying in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach to those who dwell on the earth—to every nation, tribe, tongue, and people—saying with a loud voice, "Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water." (Revelation 14:6-7, NKJV)

The message: What is proclaimed is the "eternal gospel" (Rev. 14:6, NIV). It is eternal, because it is immutable, permanently valid, and forever true. The "gospel" refers to the saving work of Christ in His incarnation, ministry, death, resurrection, and high-priestly work on our behalf. It also includes the last judgment (Rom. 2:16) and the return of Christ (1 Thess. 1:5, 9, 10). We must proclaim today that salvation is only by faith in Christ, a faith that leads to obedience.

The audience: The proclamation is universal, because the phenomenon of sin is also universal. The gospel belongs to all races and ethnic groups, because we are all sinners.

The call: This is expressed through three imperatives: "Fear God, give glory to him; . . . worship him." When confronted by the greatness of God (Ps. 96:4), His justice (Rev. 15:3, 4), and His salvation (Isa. 45:21, 22), a person surrenders to Him in faith and obedience.

To fear God is, in fact, to keep His commandments (Deut. 8:6).

This call also tells us to give glory to God, to acknowledge Him as the most loving and important factor in our lives. There is no one like Him, and by glorifying Him, we declare our alliance to Him and not to the forces of evil. To give glory to Him is not to give Him something He does not have, but it is to give Him His rightful place in our lives. This call is motivated by the fact that the final judgment, announced by Daniel, is already in progress. This is Christ's last work on behalf of sinners; it represents the last opportunity to join and follow the Lamb.

The call also deals with worship, which is central in the great controversy. Only God, not the dragon, is worthy of adoration, because only God (not the dragon) is the Creator. This call takes us back to the Sabbath as a sign of Creation; this call is a clear and blatant rejection of idolatry and the theory of evolution.

"As an indication of the approach of the end, there was, however, to be seen another angel flying through the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people. Revelation 14:6. The burden of this angel was to be the same gospel which had been before proclaimed; but connected with it was the additional motive of the proximity of the kingdom - 'saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his Judgment is come; and worship him that made heaven and earth, and the seas, and the fountains of waters.' Verse 7. No mere preaching of the gospel, without announcing its proximity, could fulfill this message." — {John Nevins Andrews, The Three Messages of Revelation 14:6-12 (1885), p. 27, para. 3}

God has given us a divine responsibility to do. Heralding the everlasting gospel to every corner of this earth.

Let's make ourselves available for this noble duty for a great reward awaits us. God bless you!


Members are requested to collect their baptismal and baby dedication certificates. Some certificates, dating back to 2024, remain uncollected.


