PASTORAL MESSAGE: "WHOLENESS"

God's plan for humanity includes vibrant health and joyful living. Ellen G. White wrote, "Health is a treasure. —Of all temporal possessions it is the most precious. Wealth, learning, and honor are dearly purchased at the loss of the vigor of health" {Christian Temperance and Bible Hygiene, p. 150}. We honor God when we care for our bodies—His temples—through nutritious food, fresh air, exercise, rest, and trust in Him. This balance promotes physical strength and spiritual sensitivity, enabling us to better serve others and glorify our Creator.

Our **mental health** is equally important in the Christian Walk. A peaceful mind, rooted in trust in God, is a powerful shield against life's stresses. Sister White encourages us: "Gratitude, rejoicing, benevolence, trust in God's love and care—these are health's greatest safeguard" (Ministry of Healing, p. 281). Dwelling on God's promises, engaging in uplifting activities, and cultivating faith and thankfulness renew the mind and sustain emotional strength in times of trial.

In contrast, **intoxicating substances** undermine both physical and spiritual life. Ellen G. White warned, "The use of intoxicating liquor dethrones reason, and hardens the heart against every pure and holy influence. The inanimate rock will sooner listen to the appeals of truth and justice than will that man whose sensibilities are paralyzed by intemperance. ..." {Temperance, p. 228}. Whether alcohol, tobacco, or modern drugs, these destroy self-control, cloud judgment, and separate us from God's purpose. True freedom arises not from external stimulants but through the empowerment of the Holy Spirit. Let us choose the best way—the way of life, health, and holiness. God bless you!
