

2. New Strategic Plan for 2025-2030

"The Annual Council meeting on October 10, 2024, the Executive Committee of the General Conference (GC) of Seventh-day Adventists voted to adopt the official World Church Strategic Plan for 2025-2030. This plan reflects the Church's ongoing commitment to spreading the gospel and fostering spiritual growth within its global membership. Developed by the Future Plans Working Group, the new plan was <u>first presented</u> at the 2023 Annual Council and has since undergone refinements based on feedback from worldwide divisions.

Key Components of the New Strategic Plan

The newly voted "I Will Go" <u>strategic plan</u> simplifies the Church's past approach while maintaining comprehensive goals. The strategic plan approved in 2013 had 81 Key Performance Indicators (KPIs), while the last plan contained 59 KPIs. The new plan features just 22 measurable goals."
