Happy Sabbath! Shabbat Shalom!

We welcome him as he prepares to speak on the subject **"Too Close Yet Too Far from Salvation"**. The message is inspired by **Matthew 7:21**.

Pastoral Message: "Come in a Disciple, Go out a Missionary"

Welcome to Pastoral, Sabbath School, and Interest Coordination Sabbath. These departments work together to promote fellowship, community outreach, global mission and bible study.

Ellen G. White did not use the modern title "Interest Coordinator" as it is known today in the Seventh-day Adventist church structure. However, she wrote extensively about the spirit and method of work that aligns with the role of an Interest Coordinator, sole purpose of Sabbath School and ministers' duties these are souls who help nurture spiritual interest, follow up on visitors, and missing members. They work to connect "Newlifers" with the right church life.

Key roles of leading departments today are:

1. Personal Work and Follow-Up Ministry

These departments help members take part in soul-winning, especially by connecting with new attendees or interests from evangelistic efforts. "Those who have the spiritual oversight of the church should devise ways and means by which an opportunity may be afforded every member of the church to act some part in God's work. It is very essential that such work be done, that each may become strong and intelligent in the service of God." — *Testimonies for the Church*, Vol. 9, p. 116

2. Visiting and Caring for Souls

These departments often organize visitations to interests, the sick, or the missing, thus reviving the spirit of Personal Ministry. "There is need of coming close to the people by personal effort. If less time were given to sermonizing, and more time were spent in ..., the sick cared for, the sorrowing and the bereaved comforted, ..." — *The Ministry of Healing*, p. 143

3. Nurturing New Converts and Interests

The Pastoral, Sabbath School and Interest coordinators ensure no contact or new believer is left unattended, especially after baptism or first contact with the church. "After individuals have been converted to the truth, they need to be looked after... These newly converted ones need nursing—watchful attention, help, and encouragement." — *Evangelism*, p. 351

4. Record-Keeping and Following Up

These departments are record keeping in nature to make sure a good data base for nurture and retaining/monitors purposes and manage spiritual interests, ensuring people are not lost between church departments. "Never should we pass by one suffering soul without seeking to impart to him the comfort wherewith we are comforted of God." — *Christ's Object Lessons,* p. 387

Set "tech-free" times to be present, pray, journal, or enjoy nature.


vii. Celebrate the Small Wins:
